Personal Sharings

I came to Al-Anon looking for answers. I thought I knew the questions, but I discovered that my thinking was so distorted by the family disease of alcoholism that I felt as though I was starting in kindergarten again! I remember gaining some insights by going to meetings, listening to members, reading Conference Approved Litetarure, and getting a sponsor; it wasn't long before I began feeling like I had moved to first grade!

I didn't know what I didn't know, so how could I change? I knew that my best thinking got me a seat in AI-Anon. The only way I could change was by accepting the grace of God. The only way I could change was a shift in my perception, thoughts, and behavior. I started acting and doing things differently from my thinking. Now I remind myself daily to "take an action, despite how I feel." My feelings will keep me stuck in my ego, self-will, self-righteousness, judgments, fears, etc.

Shifting my focus to myself was key to changing what I could. Working the Twelve Steps was changing what I could. I realized that I was a work in progress, so my journey through the Twelve Steps and my relationship with the God of my understanding have been parts of an ongoing journey.

Today, when life happens, I know I need to deepen my conscious contact with my Higher Power. My old thinking was to focus on everyone around me and tell them what they needed to do so that I would be happy. My understanding today is that my happiness is an inside job, based on my conscious contact with my Higher Power. I'm powerless over others and events that happen in my life, but I can change my perception and the actions I take when life happens.

I'm grateful that I kept coming back!
